- The rise in bomb hoax calls and their impact on various sectors.
- · The dissemination of threats through various channels.

Sources of Threats

- Email Threats
 - Threats originating from unauthorized domains.
 - Investigations launched on multiple mailing service companies.
- Case of a Teenage Boy
 - Police counselling a teenage boy for sending a bomb threat email to Delhi Police Headquarters.
 - The boy's lack of awareness regarding the consequences of his actions.
- Threats from Disgruntled Individuals
 - Multiple threats attributed to revenge-seeking or disgruntled ex-employees.
 - Threats from former students.
- Speculation of Foreign Actors
 - Possibility of foreign actors sending threats during high-risk events (festivals, elections, or VIP visits).
 - Heightened security measures in response to these threats.
 - Need for international cooperation to trace the origins of the threats.

Impact on Various Sectors

- Indigo Flight 6E 2211 Incident
 - Discovery of a bomb threat in the aircraft's lavatory.
 - Evacuation of the flight from Delhi to Varanasi.
 - Lapses in Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) during evacuation:
 - · Passengers and crew exiting with heeled footwear and luggage
 - · Chaotic evacuation process leading to panic
- Impact on Schools and Hospitals
 - Disruption of daily routines due to threats
 - Psychological fear instilled among individuals
- Impact on Airports and Travel
 - Intensified security checks at airports
 - Requirement of additional police personnel
 - Interruptions in security and baggage check-ins
 - Increased travel time for passengers



• Ongoing Pattern in Targeting Establishments

- Disruption of normal routines and business operations.
- Example: Bomb threat at Bengaluru's Kempegowda International Airport
 - Intensified security checks
 - Operations resume after a few hours once the threat is declared a hoax

Importance of Addressing Hoax Calls

- · Hoax calls cannot be entirely ignored.
- Necessity of a comprehensive strategy to mitigate risks
 - Implementation of surveillance systems
 - Proactive monitoring

- Significant vulnerabilities in security protocols across various sectors.
- Need for improved security measures and adherence to Standard Operating Procedures (SOP).
- The need for a multi-faceted approach to address the various sources of threats.
- Importance of public awareness, international cooperation, and comprehensive security strategies.
